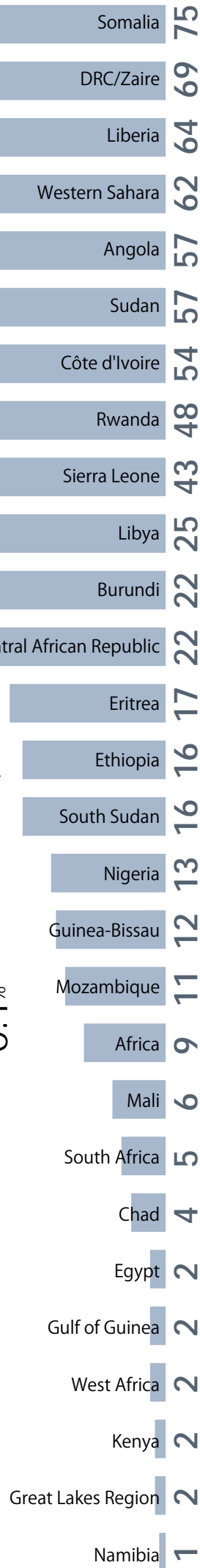

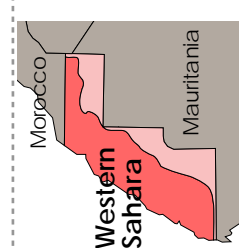
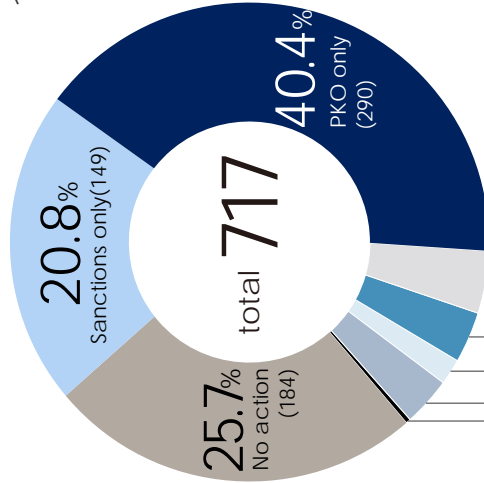
Did you know...?

Africa's proportion of resolutions was at its highest a staggering

67%



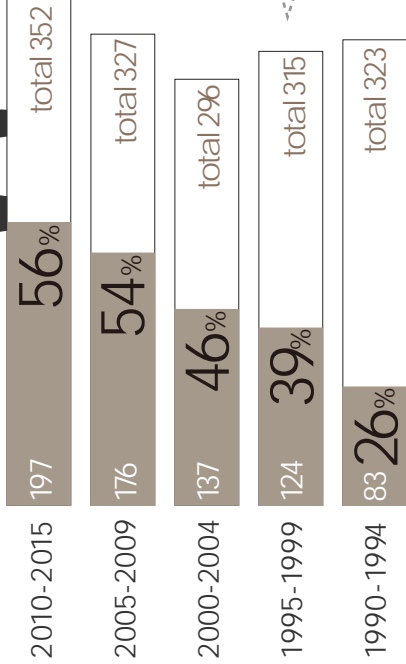

Since 1990, 62 resolutions have been adopted regarding Western Sahara, whose fate is to be decided by a referendum. 61 of the resolutions are concerning either the referendum, or MINURSO (which is tasked with organizing the referendum). The referendum has yet to take place.

Angola was the object of

the most number of resolutions for an African country in a single year:

11 resolutions in 1998.
